Rules of entry

1. Refunds will only be given with a veterinary or doctors certificate presented within 1 week of the event, less an administration fee of £1 per class
2. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN ON THE DAY
3. Dogs must be kept on a lead
4. The judge's decision is final
5. Bad language or misuse of whips/spurs will not be tolerated.
6. Riding hats PAS015 (1997) & ASTMF1163 and correct footwear must be worn at all times whilst mounted.
7. No cantering outside of the warm up area
8. All ridden horses/ponies must be at least 4ys old, sound and disease free.
9. Badly behaved or dangerous animals will be asked to leave the showground.
10. Riders must be correct height and weight for their horse/pony.
11. All reasonable steps will be taken by the O&DRC to ensure your safety. Spectators, riders and handlers attend the show at their own risk.
12. The organizers reserve the right to change, cancel, refuse or restrict a class entry at their discretion and without explanation.
13. Any objection must be made in writing to the secretary within 15 minutes of an incident taking place and must be accompanied by a deposit of £20, which may be forfeited if the objection is overruled.
14. No mucking out onto the grass.
15. All rules from the owners of the land must be complied with, failure to do so will bring disrepute on the club and will not be tolerated.
16. All litter must be disposed of responsibly.

Class 10 Family Mount

Must be suitable for all members of the family to ride

Class 11 Lead Rein

Rider 9yrs and under, snaffle bit, lead rein to be attached to the noseband

Class 12 First Ridden

No group canter, individual show in 3 paces

Class 13 Novice

Horse & rider combination never to have won a show class off lead rein. No spurs, no group canter, individual show in 3 paces, snaffle bridle only. Junior and senior riders will be placed separately.

Class 14 Riding club mount

Individual show in 3 paces and small jump will be required.

Class 15 Style & Performance horse/pony

Individual show in 3 paces and a course of small jumps will be required. Judged 50% on horses performance and 50% on riders style.

Class 16 Working Hunter Horse

Individual show in 3 paces and a course of jumps maximum height 2'6"

Class 17 Working Hunter Pony

Individual show in 3 paces and a course of jumps maximum height 2'3"

To run immediately after class 18. Open to 1st & 2nd place competitors in classes 10—17 inclusive

Open to small and large breeds, may be split if enough entries. All ponies must be eligible to be registered with an appropriate breed society

Class 19 Ridden Hunter

Horse will be required to be stripped down and ran up, individual show in 3 paces.

Class 20 Ex-Racer Ridden

Open to all Weatherbys registered TBs which have either been in training and/or raced. Ex Racers Club registered members will be placed separately within this class and 1st and 2nd placed members will qualify for the ERC 2010 championship show.
