

## **HOW TO FIND ODRC CLUB FIELD**

**From the A14 northbound exit at junction 29 to Bar Hill, then follow the signs to Willingham and Earith (B 1050). This will take you over the A14 to the right and you will come across the new roundabout. Bear left and continue to the next roundabout. At the moment you need to take the second exit (there is obviously going to be another road opened soon at the 1<sup>st</sup> exit) and continue on to the next roundabout.**

**At this roundabout take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit off to Over and continue along this road. You will pass a windmill on your right and shortly after this there is an industrial estate on the left. Go past the main entrance to this site and immediately after there is a track on the left, going down the side of the estate. The riding club field is on the right where the post and rail fencing begins.**

**From the A14 southbound exit at junction 28 to Swavesey and Over. Continue straight through Swavesey and on the outskirts of Over there is a right turn signposted “Norman Way Industrial Estate”. Take this turn and continue on until you pass Sandpit Pond on your left. The road bends around here but look out for a large house on the right and our track is immediately after the house and before the Industrial Estate. The riding club field is on the right where the post and rail fencing begins.**

**From Willingham turn towards Over at the crossroads where the Black Bull pub is on the corner. Continue towards Over and take the 1<sup>st</sup> turning to the left into Mill Road-just by the traffic calming. Continue through the wiggles until you reach the T-junction where the**

**Exhibition pub is opposite you. Turn left and continue to the T-junction at the top. Turn left and you will come to Sandpit Pond on the left. The road bends around here but look out for a large house on the right and our track is immediately after the house and before the Industrial Estate. The riding club field is on the right where the post and rail fencing begins.**
